

# Adventures with Max and the Jungle Market

*Learning objective: To identify and use adverbs to describe how actions are performed.*

Read the story about Max the monkey below. Use your knowledge of adverbs to answer the questions that follow. Remember, an adverb often describes how a verb is done and many end in -ly.

Max the monkey visited the jungle market to buy fruit for his friends. He walked quietly through the tall trees so he would not wake the sleeping sloths. When he reached the fruit stall, he looked carefully at the bunches of bananas. He chose the yellowest ones and paid the stallholder £4.50. Max hungrily ate a snack before skipping happily back home. He quickly placed the rest of the fruit into his basket so he could share them with the group.

*Word bank: quietly · quickly · carefully · happily · hungrily · neatly · suddenly*
